## Dress and Etiquette

By serving in the Ministries of Lector and EMHC, you place yourself in view of the public. **Your actions reflect upon the image of the Church.** Please dress within the expectations and dignity of the ministry. It is equally important to remember that Parishioners will hold you and the Church to a higher standard. They will base their opinions of our Church by how they witness your actions, both *outside of Church* as well as during Mass. It is imperative to practice Christian virtues at all times, and remain in good standing as a Roman Catholic.

Proper attire is semi-formal and modest at best - not casual. Slacks and a sport coat, suits, long/short sleeve shirt with tie etc. are all appropriate for Gentlemen. No shorts, cut-offs, sneakers, flip-flops, jeans etc. Shirts should not be left unbuttoned any lower than the second button (one down from the neck/tie button). Slacks are also appropriate for Ladies. No Capri's, no Spandex, and no jeans of any color please. No mini-skirts. Please make sure the length of the dress properly covers the upper legs. **Shoulders exposed by tank top, tube-top or strapless, are not appropriate.** A sweater or shawl should be worn if the shirt, blouse, or dress (sundress) does not *completely* cover the shoulders. Priests, Deacons, and Acolytes wear Albs in accordance with the dignity of their office for Celebrating Mass. **As Extraordinary Ministers and Lectors, we represent the office of those ordained and must therefore dress in accordance with its dignity.**

- **Please sign the schedule** inside the confessional, as a courtesy, 10 minutes prior to Mass. This is to assure that all servers are present. Please do not congregate, talking outside the door, as this can be disruptive to those praying before Mass. Please be inside the confessional and ready for the blessing 5 minutes before Mass is to start. Do not wait until you see the priest coming from the sacristy because they do not always come from there.
- **If you cannot serve your scheduled Mass, please find a replacement, and correct the schedule by listing who is to serve in your place.**
- **Lectors** are expected to sit on the Altar between readings. Proper etiquette is for the feet to be flat on the floor and not one leg crossed over the other. Hands are best located on your knees while sitting on the Altar to avoid distracting movement.
- **EMs** are to approach the Altar when the celebrating Priest lifts the Chalice to drink from it. If other EMs are coming from the back pews, please pause at the first pew in front of the Altar and approach the Altar as ONE GROUP.
- If there is any remaining blood in the cup after all have received, you must consume the remaining Precious Blood in place or ask the last Usher or recipient to finish it. **Do not walk to the credence table with a cup retaining precious Blood.**

If you know someone that might make a good EMHC or Lector, please ask them to consider helping our Ministry. We are in need of more EMs and Lectors. Training will be scheduled and offered several times per year for new members, and various dates will be scheduled throughout the year for continued training of EMs and Lectors.

**Notice that we are no longer using 1B, 1C & 2B, 2C.**

They are simply positions 1, 2, 3, 4 as you stand from left to right.

### **When both species are served**

#1 is the cup on the left

#4 is the cup on the right.

**If you are standing in position 1 or 4, the priest/deacon will give you the chalice. That is the species you will serve for communion. Please do not point for them to give the Chalice to another EM.**
